

2018 North Sound Regional Opioid YOUTH SERVICES FORUM REPORT

On September 12th, 2018, 110 regional partners came together to EXPLORE the path to Opioid Use Disorder for youth and young adults, CONNECT with others, and ENVISION innovative ideas to make the system work better for youth and families.

FORUM RECOMMENDATIONS INCLUDE:

- Implement evidence-based Prevention for all children. (Start early!)
- Get help for At-Risk Youth early (Wraparound, Advocates, long-term support).
- Create **School-Based Services** (intervention, treatment) in every school.
- Support an innovative "Whole-System" approach.
- Provide Medication-Assisted Treatment to all youth with OUD on demand.
- Bring services to Families (like Family Navigators, Wraparound services).
- Engage Communities to surround youth with compassion & support.
- Invest the Funding needed to support youth and families in our community.
- Change the culture to reduce Stigma.
- Create an online Information HUB to make resources accessible.
- Find more ways to support those in Recovery.
- Increase understanding of the impact of Trauma.
- Advocate for Statewide Standards for coroner testing and reporting to track opioid deaths.
