Start by identifying any independent placement criteria. If there are independent placement criteria, assign the level accordingly. If no independent placement criteria, locate the composite score in the bottom row. Review the column above. If most items are consistent with the dimension scores, assign the client to that level. If most items are inconsistent, move to the column where most items are consistent with the client's dimension scores, and apply that level.
